Agile software development in the cloud era

The workshop on Agile software development was organized by the CSI Student Branch MVJCE, in collaboration with CSI Bangalore chapter, on 16th March 2016, at MVJCE Campus. The Workshop provided an opportunity for the group of 150 students from ISE and CSE to come together and learn about the role of Agile software development in the cloud era, which covered the concepts of types of clouds, agile methods updating in different types of cloud environment and tools to upload agile software methods. The guest speaker was Jerry Kurian, who is Co-founder and CTO at MingleStats, responsible for architecting and lead developing the SAAS integration software that will synchronize data between various SAAS platforms like Shopify, Quickbooks, Maichimp etc. He is responsible for lead developing the assessment and learning software. The assessment software has been approved by a govt funded organization for assessing its skill development efforts. He worked on technologies like J2EE,CORBA, Spring 2,Axis 2, Felix OSGI framework, Ruby On Rails and cloud platforms like IBM AIX 5, Open Stack.



The workshop started in Rajalakshmi Seminar hall, MVJCE Campus at 1.30 pm with a welcome speech by Prof Besty Haris, the student branch coordinator of the CSI student Branch MVJCE, introduced the chief guest to the audience.
