Objectives of the workshop:

The main agenda is to impart knowledge in the field of IPR under the following heads:

- Importance and scope of IPR in Academic Researches.
- To understand viability of patent and types of innovations patentable.
- Procedure of patent drafting, patent filing and grant of patent.

About 32 faculty of various department participated in the program. Dr T N Shanmugam, a prominent speaker introduced our faculty to Intellectual Property Rights. Under his leadership, the CIPR, Anna University had filed over 105 patent applications. The centre CIPR is now received recognition from the WIPO (World Intellectual Property Organisation). He had lectured and still lecturing in Tamil Nadu and other states and addressed/addressing young students particularly the III year Engineering students kindling their innovative ideas so as to be a future innovators of India. In a recent international conference on "Management of Intellectual Property rights and Strategy held at IIT, Mumbai between January 30th -Feb 2, 2014 he was a chair for a session on Patent Information & Decision Strategy. This workshop was organized to inculcate and motivate faculty to file patents.

In the present workshop Dr. T N Shanmugam briefly explained the importance and scope of Intellectual Property Rights. The classifications of IPR were briefly explained. The viability of patent, patentability search, types of patent, procedure of drafting and filing the patent were highlighted in this workshop.
