



FIRST AID TRAINING PROGRAMME-9/5/2014

With guidance from our respected Principal, Dr. K S Shanmukharadhya, NSS Programme Officer Prof. R Muralidhara, and supported by Visvesvaraya Technological university (VTU) and MVJCE management, in association with Indian Red Cross Society(IRCS), a first aid training programme was conducted on 9th May 2014, at college premises.

Training was given to students and laboratory assistants of the college by DrJayakumar who is a faculty in IRCS and St John's Ambulance association. The lecture started with the brief explanation about the aims of first aid programme and basic structure of human body. The speaker told about the golden rules to be followed during emergency and the laws prevailing in India in connection to the road safety and accidents. He also explained about different types of fractures and wounds. Then he explained about the first aid to be given in case of back pain, fracture, respiratory problems, burn, electric shocks and drowning. He also gave demo of how to dress different types of wounds and during fracture. 120 students and 20 lab staffs were present for the lecture.
